

Camp Tipton Mission Team Packing List & Dress Code

What to bring to Camp Tipton overnight camps:

- Bible, notebook, pen or pencil
- Sleeping bag or linens (mattress size is 34x74x4)
- Pillow
- Towels and washcloth
- Soap, shampoo, toothpaste and toothbrush
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen and bug repellent & a comfortable baseball cap or wide-brim hat
- Bathing suit (a one-piece or modest two-piece)
- Several pair of shoes suitable for hiking (tennis shoes or walking boots)
- Enough camp type clothing for your stay (we do have a washer & dryer)
- An inexpensive watch if you have one
- An open heart and a cheerful spirit to hear God speak
- A water bottle with your name on it

What not to bring to Camp Tipton

- Knives, guns, laser lights, and anything else that might be considered a weapon
- Jewelry and expensive clothing or other valuables
- Fireworks
- Clothing that doesn't distract from your witness or your message (guys, please wear pants that don't reveal your boxers, girls, please wear pants that are appropriate for camp staff and volunteers)

Dress Code

- For camps: Shorts (should reach mid-thigh to knee), jeans (do not wear jeans that expose underwear), tee shirts (in good condition)
- For swimming: Guys (shorts that reach the mid-thigh to knee); yes, we know you are buff, but don't wear the Speedo. Girls, a one-piece, or a decent two piece; this doesn't include a teeny-tiny, yellow polka-dot bikini.
